Reports from Groups suggested some further actions.

- 1. Signposting (better name needed): 'pointing people in the right direction for the advice or support they need'.
 - Publication of support information in the pattern of the Popley/Chineham example booklet, or a series of sheets to enable continuous updating. LP Directory might be a good local example. ACTION PB, Jenny Cutbill, Lyn North, VK.
 - 3. Basingstoke Voluntary Services are reinventing *Neighbourcare* to improve its provision of services beyond transport: form-filling, befriending, short respite care. Perhaps we should look at discussions to do the same here, but also extend coverage to HbP & LP with the hope of new volunteers refreshing the scheme. ACTION PB, FW, MC to meet Eve L-S.
 - 4. Also mentioned: how the social side of baby clinics, for instance, could be improved if they were not held in a surgery but Village Hall—with coffee, etc.
- 5. Care Group: 'improving the welfare and practical support to all ages'
 - 6. Parish nursing scheme: church sponsored, it appears. ACTION JS to research examples in USA.
 - 7. Coffee-morning based advice meetings: pilot in pubs aimed at older generation, using contacts from Christina Moran's list: ACTION CH to discuss idea with Sue at Coronation Arms: VK & LN to set up outline plan of action.
 - 8. Research paper In the Dark: ACTION CH to circulate by email.
- 9. Survey: MW has researched and await further clarification of aims to enable well-directed questions.
